How it will work

1. Your care home will have a **router** installed in the main office, or elsewhere in the building.
2. Your IT manager can preconfigure **Access Points**, or WPS, for DVI to install (if they aren't installed already).
3. DVI will run additional cabling to the areas where **better connectivity** is required – this may be in two or three different locations in the care home depending on the size of the building.
4. DVI will supply and install the data cabling and containment, if required, **from the Access Point position** back to the **router**, terminate, and install the **Access Points**.
5. Connectivity and coverage is then improved in those common areas where previously reception was poor.
