




- Face masks are now mandatory for all NHS staff and visitors to NHS establishments and a face covering is compulsory for all people using public transport and visiting shops in the UK

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE




With clean or gloved hands start by looping one side of the mask to one side of the ear protector




Place the mask on your face and then connect the other loop to the other side of the ear protector

Can also be worn in a low position



The ear protector is designed to be disposable and is 100% recyclable. We produce the ear protectors from recycled Polypropolene and we endeavour to take back all ear protectors that have been disposed of and use our recycling facility to make them into new ear protectors.



The ear protector is made from polypropylene (PP). Polypropylene is a polymer plastic and is part of the 'polyolefin' (polymers produced from alkenes) family. It has many qualities such as being versatile and tough, but as a semi rigid material, it is also flexible at the same time. Most importantly, it is recyclable.



The ear protectors have been designed so they can be sterilised simply and easily at home in a dishwasher. In a medical environment we advise that the ear protector is changed after 5 days of being worn.


