Advanced Notification of Upratings for 2022/23 for - Free Personal and Nursing Care Payments; Personal Expenses Allowance (PEA); Capital Limits; and Savings Disregards

This correspondence gives advance notice of the uprating of the Free Personal and Nursing Care rates from **1 April 2022** and the Personal Expenses Allowance (PEA), and Capital Limits and Savings Disregard for residential care charging from **11 April 2022**. This correspondence is provided to assist your preparations in advance of the formal changes to the regulations made under the National Assistance Act 1948.

Please Note all of the changes in the table below are subject to Parliamentary approval of the Regulations.
