

How to set up- smart bulbs



Smart Bulbs Smart bulbs can be controlled using a smartphone app or voice commands. They can change colour, brightness, and even be scheduled to turn on or off at specific times, helping you save energy.

Step 1: Screw in the Smart Bulb

Insert the smart bulb into the light socket. Ensure that the bulb is securely screwed in but avoid overtightening. Turn on the light switch to provide power to the bulb.

Step 2: Download the App

Most smart bulbs come with a dedicated app that you need to download. Go to the app store on your smartphone or tablet and search for the app associated with your smart bulb brand. This can be found on the packaging or in the manual.

Step 3: Create an Account

Open the app and create an account if required.

Step 4: Add a New Device

In the app, look for an option to add a new device. This is typically found in the settings or device management section. Follow the app's instructions to add your smart bulb.

Step 5: Put the Bulb in Pairing Mode

If you have a smart home ecosystem, such as Amazon Alexa or Google Assistant, you can often integrate your smart bulb for voice control and automation. Follow the instructions within the app to enable these integrations.

How to use- Smart Bulbs

After setting up your bulbs you can control them through the app on your phone or through your voice assistant. When using your bulbs, you can refer to them by the name you gave them during set up such as “Living room light”. Use this name whenever you’re using the bulb with the following instructions:

Turn On/Off: "Alexa/Hey Google, turn on [bulb name]" or "Alexa, turn off [bulb name]."

Brightness Control: "Alexa/Hey Google, set [bulb name] brightness to [percentage]."

Color Control (if applicable): "Alexa/Hey Google, set [bulb name] to [color]."
