

# How to set up- smart plugs



## Step 1: Plug In the Smart Plug

Insert the smart plug into a standard electrical outlet. Ensure that the smart plug is securely inserted.

## Step 2: Download the App

Most smart plugs come with a dedicated app. Go to the app store on your smartphone or tablet and search for the app associated with your smart plug brand. Download and install the app.

## Step 3: Create an Account

Open the app and create an account if required.

## Step 4: Add a New Device

In the app, look for an option to add a new device. This is typically found in the settings or device management section. Follow the app's instructions to add your smart plug.

## Step 5: Put the Smart Plug in Pairing Mode

Smart plugs usually need to be put into pairing mode for the app to detect them. This often involves pressing a button on the plug or following a specific sequence. Refer to the plug's manual or in-app instructions for how to do this.

## Step 6: Connect to Wi-Fi

During the setup process, the app will prompt you to connect the smart plug to your Wi-Fi network. You'll need to enter your Wi-Fi credentials to complete this step.

## Step 7: Name Your Smart Plug

Once connected, you can usually assign a name to your smart plug. This name will help you identify and control the plug using voice commands or the app.

## Step 8: Using your Smart Plug

After setting up the smart plugs and giving them names such as “Bedroom lamp”, you can use these names when turning your electrical devices on and off through your voice assistant:

To turn on: say “Alexa/Her Google, turn [name of plug] on”

To turn off: say “Alexa/Her Google, turn [name of plug] off”

**Remember you must leave the device turned on at its switch for the smart plug to work!**
